What is scent work? AKC Scent Work is a sport that mimics that task of working detection dogs to locate a scent and communicate to the handler that the scent has been found. Real-life detection dogs are trained to search for a variety of things: drugs, explosives, human remains, currency, other contraband, living humans and much more. AKC Scent Work takes this amazing working relationship between a dog and its handler and turns it into a fun game that any dog can play. AKC Scent Work is very similar to Nose Work or C-WAGS (Canine-Work and Games).
